Financing & Student Aid

Scholarships and Bursaries

VAS is a designated institution by the Private Training Institutions Branch from the government of BC. This has allowed many of our past students and graduates to successfully receive a number of different scholarships and bursaries, like BC's Passport to Education and Alberta's Alexander Rutherford Scholarship. Check with your provincial student aid site to see what options are available to you.

RESPs

Registered Educational Savings Plans are available for Vancouver Acting School Students. VAS is a Designated Educational Institution where you may redeem your RESP funding. Please contact your RESP provider for details and our student services team will help you with the rest.

Student Lines of Credit

Most Canadian banks and financial institutions offer student lines of credit at comparable rates and repayment terms as an alternative to Government Loans. Student Lines of Credit can also be used to provide additional funding for living expenses throughout your studies.

Canadian Financial Aid

VAS is able to guide you through every step of the student loan process, assisting you with both the federal and provincial opportunities for support. Any student enrolled in our full-time programs are eligible. Begin the process by contacting the loan office of the province you most recently resided in for twelve consecutive months. Student loans are available to Canadian citizens and those landed immigrants with Permanent Resident status..
